SUBJECT

Approval of purchase order for replacing building lights

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Staff requests approval of a purchase order in the amount of \$19,538.00 to Sitler's Supplies for the purchase and installation of LED lights to replace all of the lights in the Transfer Station truck storage/shop/wash bay building.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council approve a purchase order in the amount of \$19,538.00 to Sitler's Supplies of Washington Iowa to replace all of the lights in the Transfer Station truck storage/shop/wash bay building. This will replace the existing light fixtures with LED fixtures.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

As part of the FY 2022 budget amendment, funds were allocated in the Transfer Station budget for this work. The light fixtures in this building are original to the 1995 construction of the facility. They are High Pressure Sodium and several are nonoperational and need replaced. The High Pressure Sodium lights are very inefficient compared to the LED light fixtures. There is a calculated payback on the cost of these lights of two years. Three quotes were received with Sitler's being the lowest at \$19,538.00. Other quotes were \$35,125.00 and \$36,363.80.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACT

\$20,000.00 is available from the Transfer Station budget for this work.
