

Subject: Grant Application



I asked for permission to submit a grant to purchase bar code scanners for a smoke detector program that we want to start up. I indicated that the amount of the grant request would be up to \$11,000 with a 10% City match. Upon further investigation, I have found that we can get the equipment that we need for approximately \$4,750. At the City Council meeting tomorrow night I would like for the amount to be revised from \$11,000 to \$4,750, making our match amount \$475.

The prices for the individual components of the proposal are:

WASP MobileAsset V5 Combo Pro w/SPT1800 software for 5 PC's, 1 mobile license - \$2200  
Each additional hand-held scanner with mobile license - \$1000  
Label printer - \$500  
Ribbon - \$15  
Labels - \$40

The particulars of the purchase include:

1 – Scanner with software	\$2200
2 – Scanners	\$2000
1- Label printer	\$ 500
Ribbon & Labels	<u>\$ 50</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$4750</b>

According to the sales representative, other than the consumables, there are no recurring costs.
