

**DEFINITIONS**

**"INSURANCE CERTIFICATE" – Proof of the insured organization's (MDA's) insurance coverage in regard to the described event or property. When a sponsoring organization requests proof of MDA's insurance coverage, MDA can prepare an insurance certificate listing the sponsoring organization as a "Certificate Holder."**

**"ADDITIONAL INSURED" – An organization/individual that is added to the insured organization's (MDA's) insurance policy in regard to the described event or property. In the event of a claim, the insurance carrier will defend both MDA and the additional insured. As long as MDA is to some degree responsible for the claim, MDA's insurance carrier will not seek reimbursement from the additional insured.**

**Additional insured status should be extended to a sponsoring person or organization ONLY when such status is specifically requested and then only as limited below.**

**MDA'S POLICY FOR SPECIAL EVENT (SE-6)**

**Paragraph (e), provides:**

The sponsoring group should assume the burden of all costs (to the extent possible) and liability of the event. The sponsoring group should obtain, at its expense, any and all liability insurance that may be required in staging any special event for which MDA has agreed to be named as beneficiary. However, when requested, sponsors and location owners can be provided a Certificate of Insurance evidencing MDA's insurance coverage or be named as "additional insureds" on the Association's liability insurance policy, using MDA's Request for Certificate of Insurance form (SE-8 R2/02).

Therefore, please note the following:

1. MDA prefers not to carry the risk of the event, if at all possible.
2. Our sponsors will be legally responsible for their sole negligence even if extended "additional insured" status.
3. MDA will not accept the liability for events such as carnivals, horseback rides and other such events where sponsors have particular expertise in conducting these activities. Under these or similar circumstances MDA will require the sponsoring organization to provide MDA with additional insured status on the sponsor's insurance policy. [See SE-6 paragraph (h).]
