SUBJECT

Request to Approve the Issuance of a Purchase Order in the Amount of \$377,372.00 to Hogle Bus Company, Inc. for Two Light Duty Buses.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Presented for the City council's consideration is a request for authorization to issue a purchase order to Hogle Bus Co., Inc. for two light duty transit buses in the amount of \$377,372.00.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Public Works/Transit staff recommend issuance of the purchase order for the buses.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The transit supervisor learned Hogle Bus Company had two light duty buses that were on order, ready to be manufactured and with a completion date in April 2024. These buses were for Hogle to have on their lot. The salesman offered the buses for MuscaBus to purchase. After reviewing our operating grant funds and realizing the FFY22 operating grant still had funds available to cover most of the operating expenses for FFY24, the Transit Supervisor contacted the Iowa DOT for guidance to move \$335,816.00 of the FFY24 operating grant to a capital grant. The FFY24 operating grant in the amount of \$536,151.00 was approved on 2/15/24 and has an expiration date of 6/30/24. After moving \$335,816.00 (85 percent of the total cost of the bus including make-ready expense) from operating to capital, \$200,335.00 will remain for operating expenses. The Transit Supervisor is in the process of completing the required items to amend the FFY24 operating grant. The Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) must be amended, then the Iowa DOT will send the request to the FTA to amend the grant.

The total cost of each bus will be \$188,686.00 plus make-ready expenses of \$8,853 for fare box, graphics and cameras, totaling \$197,539.00.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACT

The request for the purchase order in the amount of \$377,372.00 will be funded by amending our FFY24 (expiring on 6/30/2024) operating grant from \$536,151.00 for operations to \$335,816.00 capital and \$200,335.00 left for operating. Transit also had \$339,084.00 of FFY22 (expiring on 6/30/2024) operating grant left for FFY24 operating expenses.

In this contract, the words "we," "us" and "our" refer to the dealer-seller. The words "you" and "your" refer to the buyer and the co-buyer, if any.

1. CASH SALE. You agree to buy the vehicle described on the front of this document. This is not a credit document. If you obtain financing to purchase the vehicle, you will be required to sign documents which comply with applicable federal and state laws. If you obtain financing to purchase the vehicle, there will be a fee for filing the lien on the title. This fee may be paid to either the dealer or to the lending institution from whom you obtain financing.

2. WARRANTY DISCLAIMER. YOU UNDERSTAND THAT THE VEHICLE IS SOLD "AS IS" WITH ALL FAULTS AND THAT THERE ARE NO IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, or any other warranties, express or implied, covering the vehicle unless we make a written warranty to you or unless we enter into a service contract with you within 90 days from the date of this contract. If we do so, any implied warranty will last only as long as the limited written warranty.

This provision does not affect any warranties which may be provided by the manufacturer. If there is a manufacturer's warranty on the vehicle, we are not a party to it and it is not a part of this contract. If we are authorized by the manufacturer to perform warranty work on your vehicle, we hope that you ask us to perform the work. 3. YOUR FAILURE OR REFUSAL TO ACCEPT DELIVERY. If you refuse or fail to accept delivery of the purchased vehicle, we may keep your cash deposit as liquidated damages. If you had a trade-in, we may sell the trade-in and keep any part of the selling price which we need to reimburse us for losses which we incurred because you did not take delivery.

4. FAILURE OR DELAY OF DELIVERY. We are not liable for failure to deliver or delay in delivery of the purchased vehicle if the failure or delay is due, in whole or in part, to any cause beyond our control or without our fault or negligence. We are not liable to you for any consequential damages, damages to property, damage for loss of use, loss of time, loss of profits, or income or any other incidental damages arising out of the sale or use of the purchased vehicle.

5. DEALER'S REMEDIES. If you fail to perform all of the terms and conditions of this contract, we may exercise any right or remedy granted by law as well as the other remedies described in this contract.

6. ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS. You agree to sign any other documents which are required to transfer title to the trade-in vehicle or the purchased vehicle, including odometer statements, damage disclosure statements, and powers of attorney.

7. ATTORNEYS' FEES. If you default on this contract, you will pay us our costs and attorneys' fees and late charges in addition to our damages.

IF YOU HAVE A TRADE-IN:
If you are trading another vehicle as part of the price of the vehicle purchased, you agree to the following additional terms.

8. YOUR WARRANTY OF TITLE TO TRADE-IN. You must provide us with your vehicle title, correctly assigned to us. You promise that the trade-in vehicle is your property free and clear of any liens or encumbrances except as noted on the front of this contract and that all taxes and registration fees are currently paid. If we are put to any expense with respect to unpaid taxes or registration fees, you will reimburse us upon demand. If we find out that you made any misrepresentation about the trade-in, then you will pay us three times our actual damages as a result of the misrepresentation, plus our costs of collection and attorneys' fees.

9. AMOUNT DUE ON TRADE-IN. The "Trade-In Balance Owed" on the front of this contract was provided by your lienholder. If the balance is incorrect due to the fault of the lienholder, the error will be treated as a mutual mistake of fact. In other words, if you owe more money on your trade-in, you will pay us the difference or you can rescind the contract by returning the vehicle. If you owe less, we will pay (or credit) you.

10. REAPPRAISAL OF TRADE-IN. If you do not deliver the trade-in to us until the purchased vehicle is delivered to you, then we may reappraise the trade-in at the time that you deliver it to us and the new appraisal will determine the allowance to be made on the vehicle purchased. If the reappraisal is lower than the original appraisal, you may cancel this contract provided you do so before you take delivery of the purchased vehicle and surrender the trade-in.

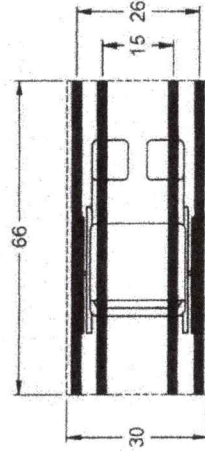
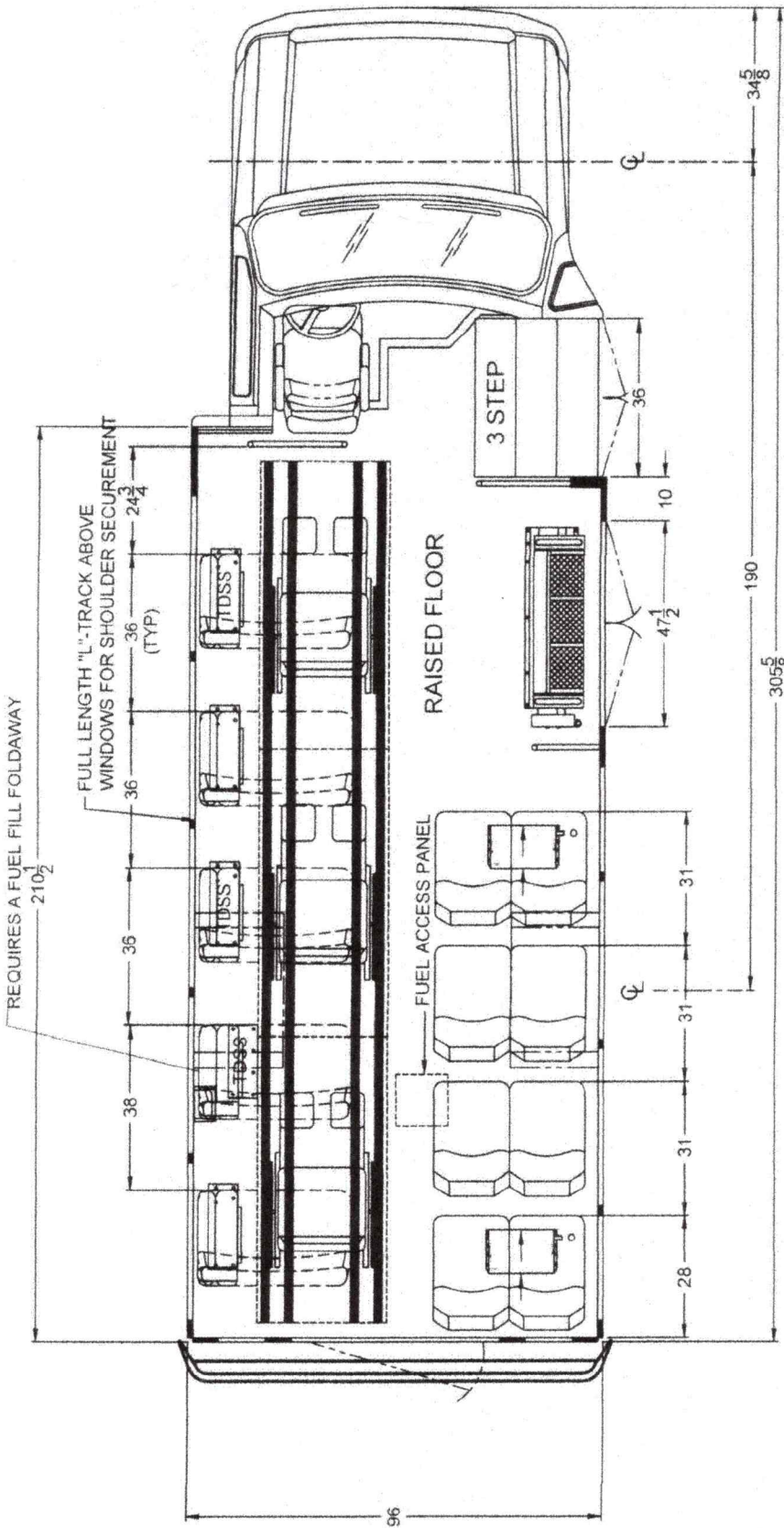

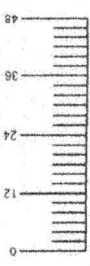
