Request To Approve the Issuance of a Purchase Order To JL Brady, Co., In The Amount Of \$53,990.00, for the Purchase of Two Mechanical Air Units For The Water & Resource Recovery Facility Grit Building

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

To request approval to issue a purchase order to JL Brady, Co. to purchase and install two mechanical air-handling units at the Grit Building at the Water & Resource Recovery Facility. Three bids were received for this purchase with the low bid coming from JL Brady, Co. in the amount of \$53,990.00. Both of these units failed this winter and need to be replaced immediately. This will be funded from the plant operations fund.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of this purchase order.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Grit Building at the WRRF has three floors, each with its own mechanical air-handling unit (MAU). The second floor MAU was replaced three years ago. The first and third floor MAUs failed this winter. The first floor MAU was repaired to the point where it would produce heat to travel up stairs to the third floor and heat both spaces. These units are vital to bringing fresh air to these areas for the safety of the staff and integrity of the equipment. Without them, safety is compromised and equipment deteriorates in the harsh environment. The third floor MAU was repaired enough to bring fresh air into the space but is not anticipated to run through the rest of the year. These units have at least a 10 week lead time for arrival and installation.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACT

This purchase will be funded from the plant operations fund.
