Bids were opened on Tuesday, September 4, 2003 for the "2003 CBD Streetscape Improvement Project". Three bids were received:

The City has \$75,000 budgeted for this project. In order to stay within budget the installation would have to be awarded to All American Concrete (\$74,967.60) and City Roadway staff would have to be responsible for removal (\$36,103.55).

I would recommend City Council award this contract to 3-D Concrete Inc. in the amount of \$97,376.50. In an attached Fund Statement provided by Nancy Lueck the Road Use Tax Fund can absorb the additional \$22,376.50 needed. The reason is the low bid we received on the cracksealing program - \$39,000 under budget. With the \$97,376.50 expenditure, the estimated 2003/2004 fund balance is still greater than what has been budgeted.

Fall begins a busy season for Roadway Maintenance personnel. Salt will be arriving late in September and Leaf Pickup begins in October. We still have full depth patches and curbs/gutters to get poured this year. There are the usual alley projects and drainage issues to work on and most importantly, we hope to get a trail installed at Kent-Stein Park.

Allowing 3-D Concrete Inc. to do the full "2003 CBD Sreetscape Improvement Project" is cost efficient and gives City crews an opportunity to continue much needed roadway maintenance before cold weather.
