## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7 POLICE REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 15 PARKING METERS AND LOTS SECTION 6 ON STREET METER RATES

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Muscatine, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT**. Title 7 Police Regulations, Chapter 15 Parking Meters and Lots, Section 6 On Street Meter Rates, of the City Code of Muscatine which currently provides as follows:

7-15-6 On Street Meter Rates. Parking or standing a vehicle in a designated space in an on-street parking meter zone shall be lawful upon the deposit of coins of the United States of America as established by Resolution adopted from time to time by the City Council.

On street parking in the parking meter district shall be for the maximum parking time limit as indicated on the parking meter or by appropriate signs, after which the vehicle shall be moved and may not be parked in that same parking stall during the next consecutive eight (8) hour period

is hereby amended to provide as follows:

7-15-6 On Street Meter Rates. Parking or standing a vehicle in a designated space in an onstreet parking meter zone shall be lawful upon the deposit of coins of the United States of America as established by Resolution adopted from time to time by the City Council.

A vehicle may be parked only once in an on street parking stall in the parking meter district for any time period up to the maximum parking time limit as indicated on the parking meter or by appropriate signs, after which the vehicle shall be moved from that parking stall. A vehicle moved from the parking stall may not be parked in that same parking stall during the next consecutive eight (8) hour period even though the vehicle was parked for less than the maximum parking time limit.

**SECTION 2. REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional

**SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

CLIENT/SUBJECT: Amendment to Parking Meter Ordinance concerning Parking only once in a metered stall each day.

On September 5, 2002, an amendment to the parking meter ordiance, Section 7-15-6, was adopted, approved and published on September 13, 2002, which we believed would clarify the interpretation of the limit on parking no longer than the maximum parking time limit (usually 2 hours) only once in a metered stall each day. The language was determined by the judicial magistrate to permit a person to park in a particular stall more than once during the day so long as the total time that the vehicle was parked in the same stall did not exceed the maximum parking time limit, i.e. park for one hour, leave the space and return to park a second time for an additional one hour making a total of two hours, the maximum parking time limit.

The attached amendment shows the amended language underlined in the second paragraph which the magistrates have reviewed and agree that the new language more clearly states the intent of the city in making the metered parking stalls more available for more citizens.

I request that upon your review and approval that this amendment be submitted to the city council for consideration and adoption.
