Re: Education Coordinator's Report, September 2007

As you can see from the attendance report, September was a busy month for us.

Our fall classes have begun, although there were no Kids' Saturday Workshops scheduled for September. Enrollment has been strong for our preschool art and music classes.

As I have mentioned, Duffy De France has decided she does not wish to continue her Wednesday afternoon "Pet Rock Studio." We have replaced that program with our "School's Out Specials," which will offer activities on days when there is no school. Julie Lear kicked off this new program on Monday, Sept. 24 with "Spooky Nichos," a multicultural project involving miniature skeletons and battery powered tea lights.

Unfortunately, we did not meet our minimum for "Little Miss Manners" again this fall. I plan to give the program one last try with "Little Mr. Manners," which is scheduled for later this fall. If there is poor response for that class we will give things a rest until we come up with a different time or parameters for these classes.

Julie Lear conducted two outreach programs at the Y in September. On Sept. 6 she showed the Teen Leaders how to create denim locker pockets. On Sept. 10 she gave a workshop on "Hardware Bracelets" to the Variety Arts kids. She also began her fall art classes for the Homeschool Attendance students with a class on Egyptian hieroglyphics.

Duffy De France represented the Art Center at the West Liberty Children's Festival on Sept. 22 with a paper hat making activity. She handed out brochures to increase awareness of our program in the West Liberty area.

Julie and I conducted a number of tours this September. Fourth-graders from Madison, Grant and Franklin, 3<sup>rd</sup> graders from Jefferson, and 6<sup>th</sup> graders from Central Middle School all came to the Art Center for tours of the Muscatine History exhibit. Those classes which were able to schedule a little additional time at the end of their tour enjoyed a "bucket brigade" activity in which they passed buckets of "water" to put out a "fire" at the mansion. Thanks to Randy Naber and Carolyn Airola for their help in bringing these school tours to the Art Center.

There were no birthday parties scheduled in September.

In addition to facilitating our fall classes and outreach programs and tours, I am currently working on plans for our winter and spring 2008 semesters, and tour curricula for our sculpture collection and the "African-American Book Illustrators" exhibit.
