Mike Knott moved that the print be purchased from Support Foundation funds spread through "Acquisitions", "Conservation", and "Exhibitions". The Support Foundation funds are budgeted for the calendar year which ends soon. The motion was seconded by Marilyn Wick. Motion carried.

Finance & Budget: Tom Spread will be given an opportunity to review the MAC's proposed budget when it becomes available.

Long-Range Planning: Barb and Eric met with Gary Carlson to discuss the status of the proposed Pearl Pavilion. The project is moving ahead.

Personnel: Barb has hired 2 people to work weekends to replace the hours Pat Carver relinquished. The 2 are Nora Pena and Diedree Pearson.

Barb received approximately 130 applications for the Office Coordinator position being vacated by Cindy Carver. Barb has "whittled" the number down to 5 and will be interviewing each of them soon.

A retirement party for Cindy will be held December 3rd. Board members will be given more details as the date draws closer.

Re: Education Coordinator's Report, October 2007

As you can see from the attached Attendance Report, October has been one of the busiest months we have experienced in some time. Combined with the current staffing challenges at the Art Center, this fact gave a whole new meaning to the phrase, "May you live in interesting times." The drop in paid enrollment over Oct. 2006 is accounted for by the facts that attendance is down in Julie Herold's Art for Tots classes and that Pet Rock Studio has been discontinued.

Our Saturday Kids' workshops began in October. On Oct. 6 & 20 Duffy De France conducted a clay workshop in which the students learned about Mexican clay wall masks and created one of their own. Our thanks to Mary Alice Sessler for her help with this workshop. Vada Baker taught one of her oil painting work shops on Oct. 13. The children learned about blending colors on the canvas as they created colorful seascapes. Julie Lear wrapped up our October kids' workshops with "Mr. Skinny Bones," in which the students created giant skeletons out of PVC pipe and fittings to decorate their yards for Halloween.

Our October "School's Out Special" was a workshop in which the students created Jacko-lanterns using edible decorations.

Vada Baker taught a Victorian pumpkin decorating workshop for adults on Thurs. Oct. 25.

Although enrollment in our preschool classes remains strong, we have noticed some reduction in attendance in Julie Herold's Art for Tots program this fall.

Julie Lear conducted three outreach programs at the Y in October. The Teen Leaders made beaded skeleton pins, the Variety Arts group created milk bottle skeletons, and the High school kids cast concrete stepping stones. Julie also went to Happy Time Preschool and presented five programs as the "Music Lady." Julie also represented the Art Center at the Musser Library's Halloween Story Time with our rendition of "The Little Old Lady who wasn't afraid of Anything" and her four-verse version of the "Itsy Bitsy Spider." Homeschool Assistance art classes continued in October, with workshops on Chinese Peasant Painting and Italian Majolica tiles. I am subbing for Andy Tabor, who is on leave while he recovers from his surgery. The Art Center also hosted the Homeschool Assistance students in their science enrichment program in October.

Julie and I conducted tours of the History Exhibit for McKinley, Washington & Colorado 4th graders & Homeschool Assistance students in October. In addition to the history tours, students from West Middle School participated in tours featuring the Art Center's sculpture collection. Linda Kelty is planning to make these tours a part of her regular curriculum, to be repeated in the spring semester.

On October 9 I conducted a tour of the mansion for the Alpha Club a combination tour of the mansion and the history exhibit for Scott Community College Continuing Education.

On Sunday Oct. 28 Julie hosted author John Duggleby's program on African American artist Jacob Lawrence in conjunction with the African-American Book Illustrators exhibit in the Stanley Gallery. Mr. Duggleby's program, based on his book "Story Painter," was followed by a book-signing and reception.

There were no birthday parties scheduled in October.

In addition to facilitating our fall classes and outreach programs and tours, I am currently working on plans for our winter and spring 2008 semesters, and a tour curriculum for the "African-American Book Illustrators" exhibit.

I want to especially commend Julie Lear, who held things together for us in the education department this month while I was sick with this stupid, stupid virus!
