7:00 p.m. - February 21, 2008

Mayor Dick O'Brien called the City Council meeting for Thursday, February 21, 2008, to order at 7 p.m. Councilmembers present were Press, Fitzgerald, Howard, Shihadeh, Bynum, Roby, and Lange.
