
PRESENT: Mayor Platt, Councilmembers Kemp, Kite, Sayles, York

The City Council met at 4:30 p.m. in the lobby of Muscatine
Power & Water Building on Cedar Street. The Council with the members
of the Power & Water Board of Trustees then left for a tour of
the new Power Plant - Unit #9. Council returned to the Power &
Water Administrative Building on Cedar Street at 7:00 p.m. After
dinner, a tour was provided of the Administrative facilities including
the System Control Center, garage/warehouse, and business computer
facilities.

The Council and the Board then held a general discussion concerning
the following Muscatine Power & Water's budget before and after
Unit #9; a summary of benefits to the citizens of Muscatine from
the municipal utility as outlined including benefits to the taxpayers
of Muscatine; a general discussion concerning the new service boundries
of Power & Water; future joint projects between the City and Power
& Water including the Olive Branch Water Project, Industrial Connector,
and traffic and street lighting for the new U.S. 61 By-Pass.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 9:30 p.m.
