## REGULAR MONTHLY SESSION OF CITY COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Her Honor, Mayor Evelyn L. Schauland.

The Opening Prayer was given by Corporation Counsel Harvey Allbee, Jr.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

## PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Schauland announced the purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comment on the proposed storm sewer project on Robin Road from Bidwell to Crestline.

There were no oral appearances for or against.

There were no written petitions for or against.

- #5437. Ald. Platt moved to approve the Minutes of the In-Depth Council Meeting of April 9, 1981. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5438. Ald. Rada moved to approve the Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of April 16, 1981. Second by Ald. Duncan. All ayes; motion carried.
- Mr. Chris Harvey, R.R. 6, Box 63, representing DeMolay, stated that this organization is interested in performing a civic project for the City and requested suggestions from the City. This item was referred to the City Administrator.

Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes: Ald. Platt, Koehrsen, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Duncan and Waltman. Motion carried and Resolution duly adopted.

City Administrator Wolff reviewed the bids received for the Houser Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project.

Hilton moved to approve the Resolution awarding contract for the Houser Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project to Langman Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$208,337.50 with Items #1 and #2 of the bid to be performed on a time and materials basis. Second by Ald. Duncan. All ayes: Ald. Platt, Koehrsen, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Duncan and Waltman. Motion carried and Resolution duly adopted.

#5452. Ald. Waltman moved to approve the Resolution setting a public hearing on May 21, 1981, at 7:30 p.m. concerning the request to park in the City right-of-way at 923 West Third Street. - #5456. Ald. Kemp moved to approve the agreements with the Iowa Department of Transportation for the utilization of FAUS funds for the repair of the Washington and Clay Street Bridges. Second by Ald. Platt. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5457. Ald. Platt moved to approve the agreement with the Iowa Department of Transportation for the repairs and improvements to Cedar Street from Fulliam Avenue to Parham Avenue. Second by Ald. Waltman. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5458. Ald. Waltman moved to declare the list submitted with the agenda as surplus property to be sold at a public auction. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5459. Ald. Duncan moved to approve the request to utilize Weed Park for the Third Annual Melon City Criterium. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5460. Ald. Waltman moved to authorize the Muscatine High School Athletic Department to construct a pressbox and scoring tower at Bruner Field on top of the existing concession stand with such structure to be donated to the City. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5461. Ald. Rada moved to approve the agreement with the Coast Guard Auxiliary to utilize the levee for their annual beer tent during Great River Days. Second by Ald. Waltman. Six ayes; one nay (Ald. Duncan). Motion carried.
- #5462. Ald. Hilton moved to approve Housing Rehabilitation Grants for Applicant No. 92b, 93 and 94. Second by Ald. Koehrsen. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5463. Ald. Kemp moved to approve the agreement with Iowa East Central T.R.A.I.N. for that agency to perform mini-rehabs in an amount not to exceed \$10,000. Second by Ald Duncan. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5464. Ald. Duncan moved to accept the bequest in the amount of \$1,000 from Anna Strohmeier for the Greenwood Cemetery. Second by Ald. Platt. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5465. Ald. Platt moved to receive and file items A through P. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes; motion carried.
- #5466. Ald. Koehrsen moved to approve bills totaling \$527,029.26 and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to issue warrants of the same. Second by Ald. Hilton. All ayes; motion carried.
- Ald. Koehrsen stated that a program should be formulated for construction of new sidewalks adjacent to schools to be completed in the next few years.
- Ald. Rada reported that he had received a request for a street light by the Bidwell Bridge. City Engineer Ray Childs stated that the lights were originally installed in this location to light the detour during reconstruction of the bridge and were then removed. City Administrator Wolff stated that staff will take a look at the lighting in this area.

Ald. Kemp reported that he has received several complaints on the condition of Fifth Street and requested that at least something be done about the railroad tracks.

#5467. Ald. Platt moved to approve the Resolution approving an amended outline development plan, preliminary development plan and final development plan for Lincolnshire Village. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes: Ald. Platt, Koehrsen, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Duncan and Waltman. Motion carried and Resolution duly adopted.

#5468. Ald. Platt moved to approve the Resolution approving Lincolnshire Estate, an addition to the City of Muscatine, Iowa. Second by Ald. Rada. All ayes: Ald. Platt, Koehrsen, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Duncan and Waltman. Motion carried and Resolution duly adopted.
