CITY OF MUSCATINE  
SPECIAL SESSION OF CITY COUNCIL  
Council Chambers - February 27, 1992 - 4:30 p.m.

Mayor John Keig called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Councilmembers Gary Gray, Freese, Phillips, Kemp, Moench, and Dan Gray present. Councilmember Fitzgerald absent.

Mayor Keig asked that a proclamation be approved declaring March 2-8, 1992 as "Single Parents Week".

#13124. Councilmember Kemp moved the proclamation be approved. Seconded by Councilmember Moench. All ayes; motion carried.

City Administrator A.J. Johnson told Councilmembers that they had before them a copy of the the notice of the public hearing to be held on March 5, 1992 at 7:30 p.m. concerning the City's proposed budget for fiscal year 1992/93. He stated that the information attached to the notice was a compilation of all action taken during the budget review process. He pointed out that the notice shows a total tax levy of \$12.45per \$1,000 of assessed valuation.

Nancy Lueck, Assistant Finance Director, gave a brief overview of the information provided to the Councilmembers.

Councilmember Fitzgerald arrived at the meeting at 4:35 p.m.

Councilmember Phillips stated that during the budget process there had been discussion on the purchase of a fire truck, and she asked where she could find that information.

City Administrator Johnson stated that the figure for Community Protection for the proposed fiscal year 1992/93 budget includes \$200,000 for the purchase of a fire truck and \$70,000 for the purchase of five police vehicles.

Councilmember Phillips asked if the City would be obligated to spend that money.


City Administrator Johnson answered no. He told Councilmembers that the budget sets the parameters under which departments and Councilmembers can authorize expenditures for activities, noting that the City is not obligated to spend the money allocated.

There was further discussion on the funds allocated for the purchase of a fire truck.

Seconded by Councilmember Phillips. All ayes: Councilmembers Gary Gray, Freese, Phillips, Kemp, Moench, Fitzgerald, and Dan Gray. Motion carried and resolution duly adopted.

#13126. Councilmember Kemp moved the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Councilmember Phillips. All ayes; motion carried.
