**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A GRANT APPLICATION FOR HISTORIC
PRESERVATION IN THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, IOWA**

WHEREAS, the City of Muscatine completed a survey of historic structures and sites within the City of Muscatine in 1977; and

WHEREAS, the city received grant funding in 2003 to complete a Planning For Preservation Program that includes a recommendation to conduct an intensive survey and evaluation of potential historic district sites within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Muscatine Historic Preservation Commission has identified a portion of the downtown area as the location to conduct one of these intensive surveys and evaluations; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA), through the State Historical Society of Iowa, offers funding assistance through the National Park Service's Historic Preservation Fund; and


WHEREAS, the City of Muscatine has developed a 2004 Historic Preservation Fund application that seeks \$11,274 in funding assistance to conduct an intensive survey and evaluation of the city's downtown area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, IOWA to approve a motion to submit a Historic Preservation Fund application to the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs that seeks historic preservation funding assistance to complete a historic preservation survey and evaluation of the downtown area.

ACTION Approve Certified Local Government (CLG) grant application.
REQUESTED: Application deadline: August 29, 2003

CITY'S ROLE & OBLIGATION: The City of Muscatine is the applicant. The city must provide a minimum of 40% match. The city's match can be cash or in-kind. The application proposal includes a 40% in-kind match – no cash match.

PROJECT TITLE: 2004 Intensive Downtown Survey and Evaluation

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Grant funds would be used to hire a consultant and conduct an intensive survey and evaluation of the city's downtown. Approximately 150 resources are expected to be evaluated in the approximately 15 sq. block area.

BACKGROUND /RATIONALE: The proposal is a natural extension of a CLG-funded Planning For Preservation Program that will be completed in a few weeks. The survey and evaluation will begin a phased replacement of a 1977 survey that is now outdated.

PROJECT DURATION: 12 - 18 months. Notification of funding would occur in December.

BUDGET: \$18,742.00 (CLG grant request [60%] - \$11,245.00)
(city match [40%] - \$7,497.00)
