SUBJECT: Fuel Tank Bids

Sealed bids were received for a new 10,000 gallon fuel tank and dispensing system on Thursday June 26, 2008 for the WPCP. This fuel system will replace the old one that did not meet either the Fire or Building Code. We received estimates to dispose of our old system at a cost of \$2,500- \$3,000. We were able to sell the old system by taking bids and received \$900. Everything has been removed and we will need the new system before we start hauling our bio-solids in September and October. There is an estimated 6-8 week delivery on all of the proposed systems.

The bids for the new system are as follows:

We have reviewed all of the bids and they all meet our specifications. I am recommending the acceptance of the low bid of \$32,580.03 from CPEC in Blue Grass, Iowa. This is a capital outlay project for FY 08-09 with \$30,000 being the estimated budget amount. We need this item on the council agenda for the 3rd of July to avoid any delays of getting the system installed and running by September.

CAT, RECAT Technical Assistance Workshops Offered

Four technical workshops on how to apply for Community Attraction and Tourism (CAT), River Enhancement Community Attraction and Tourism (RECAT) and marketing grants from the Vision Iowa Board will be held Friday, August 1, and Tuesday, August 26. Two sessions will be offered each day: 10 a.m. – Noon and 1 – 3 p.m.

The CAT program has been extended through fiscal year 2013. The RECAT program, created during the 2008 Legislative Session, has \$52 million available over the next five fiscal years.

Vision Iowa Program Manager Alaina Santizo will lead the sessions and present tips on how to make an application more successful. She will also answer questions about the application process.
