There were no oral appearances for.

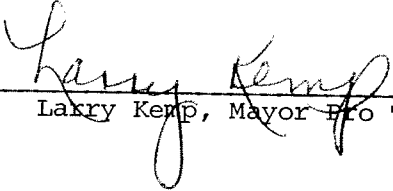
