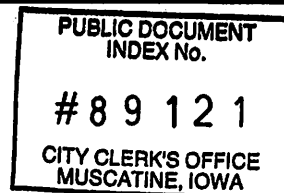

Subject: Request to Move a House



I have been contacted by Wayne and Debra Strause regarding the approval process for relocating an existing home in the City to a new location. The existing home is located at 3200 Highway 61 North, in the Taylor Land Development Subdivision. Generally, this home is located between Allsteel and Blaine's. The Strause family has secured Goodwin House Movers to relocate the house to a new foundation currently under construction on Lot 4, Oak Valley Addition, 2103 University Drive.

In accordance with Title 8, Chapter 8 of the City Code, the City Council must approve a request to move a building across city streets and rights-of-way. To assist in their review, I have requested, and the owners have provided, a sketch of the route, a proposed date to complete the move, a letter from Allsteel allowing them to cross their property, a letter from REC, and a statement that they have arranged an escort through the Police Department.

All information is currently in hand except the letter from Allsteel. When this letter is received, I will also forward it to you for Council review and approval. Subject to receipt of the letter from Allsteel, this office has no objection to the request. With that in mind, please place this matter on the agenda for City Council consideration during their July 15th meeting.

To the Muscatine City Council:

We, Wayne & Debra Strause request the house located at 3200 Highway 61 North, purchased by us on July 1, 2004, be allowed to be moved to a new location. The new location is Lot 4 Oak Valley Addition on University Drive. This move is scheduled for July 27, 2004, starting at 9 a.m., or in the event of rain, the next possible day.

Goodwin House Moving Company is contracted to move the house. They have filed all appropriate papers with the city of Muscatine for 2004. Their family has been moving houses for several generations and are considered experts in their field. They will provide front and rear escort service and Lt. Talkington of the Muscatine Police Dept. has been contacted to provide traffic control during the moving of the house.

Included with this request are letters from an Allsteel Inc. representative granting permission to cross their property to University Drive, and from REC, stating they will be present during the move. Also included is a map showing the transportation path to be taken. Estimated time of the actual move is 20 minutes.
