The requirements of 49 CFR Part 26, Regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, apply to this contract. The Owner has established a DBE contract goal of five percent (5%) for this contract. Award of this contract will be conditioned upon satisfying the requirements of this section.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to the City of Muscatine, Iowa.

Bids may be held by the City of Muscatine, Iowa until July 3, 2008, for Federal funding purposes.

It is the intent of the City of Muscatine, Iowa, to make award of contract to the responsive and responsible bidder that submits the most advantageous bid. The right is reserved by the City of Muscatine, Iowa, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

Attached hereto, please find the resolution approving the plans, specifications, form of contract, cost estimate and establishing a bid opening date for the acquisition of snow removal equipment for the Municipal Airport.

As a reminder, the engineers cost reflects the total cost for the purchase of:

1. A 14-foot Power Reversible Plow and a 4X4 Carrier Vehicle with Dump Body, and
2. An 11-foot Rollover Power Reversible Plow for the Existing Truck.

The engineers estimate for this purchase is \$157,894.00 which would be paid as a 95% federal and 5% local cost share.
