Re: Resolution Approving Amendment #1 to the 2011/2012 City Budget

### **Introduction and Background:**

On February 15, 2012 City Council set a public hearing for March 1, 2012 concerning amendment #1 to the 2011/2012 City budget and the notice of public hearing was published in the *Muscatine Journal* on February 18, 2012.

### **Recommendation:**

Attached is the resolution to approve amendment #1 to the City's 2011/2012 fiscal year budget. This resolution will amend the 2011/2012 budget to the Revised Estimate amounts considered by City Council during their 2012/2013 budget review process. This includes amending both revenues and expenditures to the currently estimated amounts. Amendments include updated revenue estimates, updated capital project construction schedules, additional grant-funded projects, and other increased operating costs.
