

The City Council is requested to set a Public Hearing on the Central Business District Miscellaneous and West 3rd Street Sanitary and Storm Sewer Improvements Project at the April 21, 2005 Council Meeting. This project is one of the Once Cent Local Option Tax projects approved by the Public in January 2004. The construction proposed includes:

1. Replace the sanitary sewer on W. 3rd between Chestnut and Cherry Streets
2. Eliminate a storm sewer outfall (SSO) and redirect to Papoose by replacing a storm line on the riverfront at Iowa Ave.
3. Install flood and odor control structures at Sycamore and Mississippi Drive
4. Install an odor control structure on E. 3rd St. across from City Hall
5. Separate sewers and install new where needed between Cedar - Orange - E. 5th - E. 9th Streets

For the Public Hearing on May 5th Mike Knott, Stanley Consultants representative, will provide you with a memorandum giving the estimated costs and a bid opening date for this project. Mike, or a Stanley's representative, will be in attendance to answer any question the city Council might have.
