There were no written petitions for.

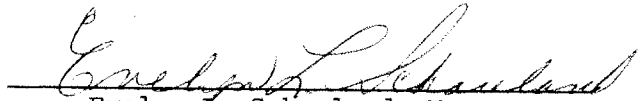
Mr. Max Churchill, chairman of the Muscatine Art Center Board of Trustees, spoke regarding the cut of the Assistant to the Director position from the budget.

Ms. Linda Dagel, Assistant to the Director of the Art Center, outlined the duties and advantages of having this position.

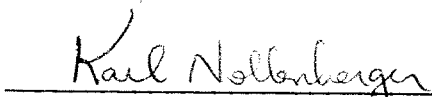
Mr. Churchill urged Council to reconsider this budget cut and reinstate this position into the budget.

There were no written petitions for.

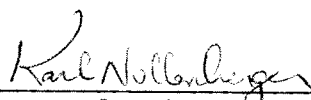

There were no written petitions for.

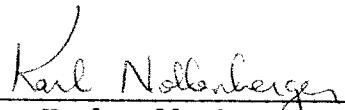
