

MINUTES

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

January 29, 1979 - 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Evelyn L. Schauand called the meeting to order.

Present: Ald. Platt, Waltman, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Koehrsen, and Robinson.

The Mayor declared a public hearing to consider the lease of property at the Muscatine Municipal Airport to Jack Barton, d/b/a Muscatine Skyhawks. John Hintermeister appeared in favor of the lease of the property representing Mr. Jack Barton. No petitions received in favor. No persons appeared against the lease of the property. No petitions were received.

#3531. Ald. Platt moved to approve a resolution approving a Fixed Base Operator's Lease and Airport Manager's Agreement, seconded by Ald. Robinson. Six ayes and one nay (Koehrsen).

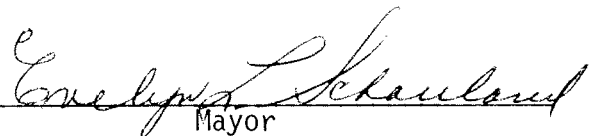
The Council heard a report from the Legal Services Committee. The report was made by Chairman John Hintermeister. He discussed the alternatives the Committee had discussed as well as their recommendation for retention of a full time City Attorney with a retainer for a Corporation Counsel. He felt that the Corporation Counsel would provide continuity to the legal situation in the City. The City Attorney would have some skills and be a full time position. This would require a change in the ordinance and classification plan.

#3532. Ald. Platt moved to accept the Legal Services Committee's recommendation and to put together an ordinance and resolution necessary to implement it along with making it clear to the departments and agencies of the City that the City Attorney would be their legal counsel, seconded by Ald. Koehrsen. All ayes, motion carried.

Ald. Koehrsen noted she would like to see a review of the system at the end of one year.

The City Council discussed the Wastewater Treatment budget.
