

IN DEPTH COUNCIL MEETING
MINUTES

February 8, 1979 - 7:00 p.m.

Council Chambers

Mayor Pro Tem Robinson called the meeting to order.

The first item of business was a joint meeting with the Plan and Zoning Commission to discuss the two-mile subdivision limit. A discussion of the requirements for subdivisions within the two-mile limits was undergone between the City Council and the Plan and Zoning Commission.

#3565. Ald. Waltman moved to adopt the resolution concerning approval of and application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for 50 additional housing units under the Section 8 Existing Housing program and setting February 15th at 7:20 p.m. as a public hearing on the application, seconded by Ald. Hilton. All ayes, motion carried.

#3566. Ald. Kemp moved to write a letter to the four industries and Lutheran Homes to terminate the fire protection service contract for outside the City fire protection, seconded by Ald. Platt. The motion was later rescinded. The Council directed the City Administrator to write a letter to the four industries currently having fire protection contracts outside the City limits and to Lutheran Homes indicating that the Council was considering the possibility of rescinding fire service to those properties and requesting their input.

#3567. Ald. Kemp moved to send a letter to Mr. and Mrs. Leslie Hendriks informing them that the City was not desirous of providing fire protection outside the City limits, seconded by Ald. Koehrsen. All ayes, motion carried.

The City Council discussed the proposed ordinance for smoke detectors within the City limits. They indicated that they were not interested in proceeding with smoke detectors at this time.

The City Council discussed the proposed Animal Control Ordinance for the City. They indicated that they would like to have the Animal Control Ordinance on the February 15th agenda with a couple of modifications.

The City Council reviewed the budgets for the Legal Services, Community Development Administration, Planning, Housing, Roadway Maintenance, Street Cleaning and Snow and Ice Control.

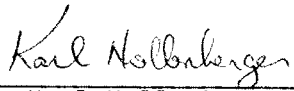
#3568. Ald. Waltman moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Kemp. All ayes, motion carried.
