

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MINUTES

February 26, 1979 - 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Pro Tem John Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Evelyn L. Schauland arrived at 7:20 p.m.

PRESENT: Ald. Platt, Waltman, Rada, Hilton, Kemp, Koehrsen, and Robinson

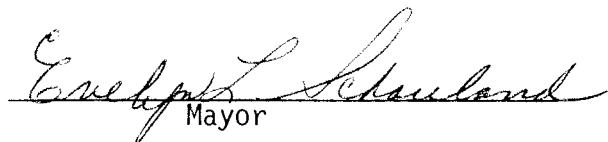
The Mayor Pro Tem indicated that the session this evening was for the purpose of discussing and making decisions of the 1979/80 budget. The City Administrator gave a brief rundown on the status of Council's decision making process on the budget. He indicated a formal public hearing would be held on March 1st at 7:10 p.m. with the possibility of the Council adopting the budget by resolution the same evening.

#3505. Ald. Koehrsen moved to request an ordinance be drawn up to remove the levee on the Mississippi from the park south from under the responsibilities of the Levee Commission and designate it as the responsibility of the Water Pollution Control Plant. Six ayes, one nay (Robinson).

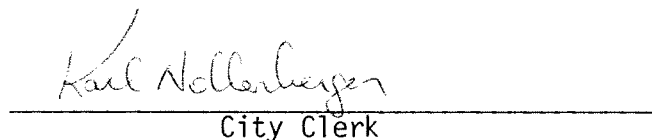
#3506. Ald. Kemp moved to move towards making the Levee Commission an advisory commission, seconded by Ald. Platt. Four ayes, three nays (Waltman, Robinson, Rada). Ald. Kemp moved to request the Corporation Counsel to draw up an ordinance making the Levee Commission into an advisory commission, seconded by Ald. Platt. Four ayes, three nays (Waltman, Robinson, Rada).

#3507. Ald. Waltman moved to proceed with the plans and specifications on the boat harbor expansion project on the riverfront, seconded by Ald. Robinson. All ayes, motion carried.

#3508. Ald. Kemp moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Waltman. All ayes, motion carried.
