

MUSCATINE CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES - BUDGET SESSION
THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 1995, 4:30 PM
CITY HALL CONFERENCE ROOM

The city council budget meeting for Tuesday, February 14, 1995, was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Mayor Jeanette Phillips. Council Members present were Dan Gray, Glenn Moench, Ralph Freese, Dick O'Brien, Phil Fitzgerald, and Kevin Fitzgerald.

Staff present: City Administrator A.J. Johnson and Finance Director David Casstevens.

The first item on the agenda for review was a presentation by library board representatives and staff concerning the proposed Library Needs Assessment Report. Representing the library board was Margaret Myers. Also present was Marsha Tate, Library Director, and Mr. George Lawson, independent consultant for the needs assessment project. Lawson gave an overview concerning the building needs for the library and the options the board is currently exploring.

The next item on the agenda was an overview of the entire Water Pollution Control Plant operation. Council discussed the Pumping Operations, Administration, Collection and Drainage, Laboratory Operations, and Sludge Disposal. At this time council also heard recommendations from staff for a proposed rate increase for residential, industrial, and commercial activities.

Council Member Gary Gray joined the meeting at 6:52 p.m.

Council then reviewed the Housing Operations, including Clark House, Section 8 Voucher and Certificate programs, the 15 scattered sites, and the Hershey Manor management contract.

With no further items to discuss, council adjourned the meeting at 8:07 p.m.
