AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 7 OF THE CITY CODE FOR MUSCATINE, IOWA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, IOWA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 1-2-7(A) and 1-2-7 (B) are hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

- 1-2-7 Penalties and Procedures for Municipal Infractions.
- (A) The following definition shall be definitions of the words so defined unless the context of the Section dictates otherwise:
 - "Repeat Offense" is a recurring violation of the same section of the City Code.
- (B) Violations, penalties, and alternative relief.
 - (1) Any violation of the City Code, with the exception of any violation which is a felony or misdemeanor under state law, is a municipal infraction.
 - (2) Unless other civil penalty is provided elsewhere in this Code for a specific violation, a municipal infraction is a civil offense punishable as provided in the following schedule of civil penalties: 1st offense, \$100.00; 2nd offense, \$200.00; and third and subsequent offense(s), \$300.00.
 - (3) Each day that a municipal infraction occurs and/or is permitted to exist constitutes a separate offense.
 - (4) Seeking a civil penalty as authorized in this Section does not preclude the City from seeking alternate relief from the Court in the same action. Such alternative relief may include, but is not limited to an order for abatement, authorizing the City to abate or correct the violation providing that the City's costs for abatement or correction be entered as a personal judgment against the Defendant or assessed against the property where the violation occurred or both, or injunctive relief.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 2, SEC-TION 7 OF THE CITY CODE FOR MUSCATINE, IOWA BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSCATINE, IOWA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 1-2-7(A) and 1-2-7 (B) are hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
1-2-7 Penalties and Procedures for Municipal

(A) The following definition shall be definitions of the words so defined unless the context of the Section dictates

_ (1) "Repeat Offense" is a recurring violation of the same section of the City Code.

(B) Violations, penalties, and alternative relief.

(1) Any violation of the City Code, with the exception of any violation which is a felony or misdemeanor under state law, is a municipal infraction.

(2) Unless other civil penalty is provided elsewhere in this Code for a specific violation, a municipal infraction is a civil offense punishable as provided in the following schedule of civil penalties: 1st offense, \$100.00; 2nd offense, \$200.00; and third and subsequent offense(s), \$300.00.

(3) Each day that a municipal infraction occurs and/or is permitted to exist constitutes a separate offense.

(4) Seeking a civil penalty as authorized in this Section does not preclude the City from seeking alternate relief from the Court in the same action. Such alternative relief may include, but is not limited to an order for abatement, authorizing the City to abate or correct the violation provid-ing that the City's costs for abatement or correction be entered as a personal judgment against the Defendant or assessed against the property where the violation occurred or both, or injunctive relief.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

and publication as provided by law.
